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Bowdoin Completes Amherst Crossing

Amherst, New Hampshire - Bowdoin Construction and Berkshire Development recently completed the construction of this 104,000 s.f. multi-tenant retail center. The project, designed by Jacobs/Edwards & Kelcey, was constructed of structural steel, concrete block, masonry and EIFS facade and TPO roof.

Sustainable design features:

One of the unique aspects of the project was its extensive use of pervious paving, which allows stormwater to percolate through to the soil below. Bowdoin coordinated with their subcontractors and suppliers to ensure proper installation of what is the largest use of pervious paving in New Hampshire.

Additional sustainable design features for this project include white reflective roofing, rain gardens, infiltration basins, and a gravel wetland system.

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
